

Bloomington Public Schools Advocacy Council Bylaws

Approved March 21, 2018

MEMBERSHIP:

- Total
 - 5 Parents
 - 2 Board members
 - Chair of Board Legislative Committee
 - Chair of Board Community Engagement Committee
 - 8 Community members
 - Superintendent and Executive Director of Community Relations – Ex officio
- No term limit
- Each member will be a voting member (Ex officio members don't vote)
- Recruitment – BPSAC Board members responsible
- Appointment process
 - BPSAC to meet the candidate
 - BPSAC to discuss the candidate
 - BPSAC Chair and the two Board reps to agree on a recommendation
 - Board Chair to bring recommendation to the Board for action
- Board can remove a member

QUORUM:

- 75% of appointed members

VOTING:

- Each member will have one vote
- No absentee or proxy voting
- Need quorum for Action
- Action = simple majority vote of quorum

OFFICERS

- Chair and Vice Chair – one year terms
- Elected by BPSAC Action

MEETINGS

- Minimum of six (6) per school year

MEETING RULES

- Informal
- Chair can invoke Robert's Rules of Order
