

BLOOMINGTON PUBLIC SCHOOLS ADVOCACY COUNCIL BYLAWS 2022

Approved Feb. 16, 2022; amended May 4, 2022

MEMBERSHIP:

- Five Parents/guardians
- Two Board members:
 - Chair of Board Legislative Committee
 - Chair of Board Community Engagement Committee
- Eight Community members
- One student representative from each high school
- Superintendent and Community Relations Department representative – Ex officio
- Each member will be a voting member (Ex officio members don't vote)
- Appointment: Members appointed to two-year term with option for renewal with no more than three unexcused absences per year and full compliance with BPSAC expectations and goals.

TERM LIMIT: None

RECRUITMENT: Board members responsible

APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL PROCESS:

- Prospective members referred to BPSAC chair for review and application
- BPSAC to discuss the candidate
- BPSAC Chair and two Board members to agree on a recommendation
- BPSAC Chair brings recommendation to the Board for action
- BPSAC Chair recommends member removal to the Board for their approval

VOTING:

- Requires 75% of attending members
- Each member has one vote
- No absentee or proxy voting
- Quorum requires a simple majority vote of those in attendance.

OFFICERS

- Chair and Vice Chair serve one-year terms
- Elected by BPSAC Action

MEETING RULES

- Meet as needed throughout academic year
 - Informal
 - Chair can invoke Robert's Rules of Order
