- \$15 for Membership. Membership gives you the right to vote at meetings **District Parent and Family Advisory Council Report:** Jevin Pinske, OGM's District Parent and Family Advisory Council Meeting Representative
  - Meets the first Wednesday of every month unless there is a holiday break for school
  - Strategic Plan was discussed; was accepted by the School Board in June.
    Everything will be online for that (Mission, Vision, Core Values)
    - Next steps: Teams of 10-12 of staff, parents and community
  - Stadium Plans: Lincoln Field/Bloomington Stadium located at 90th and Penn will no longer be used. Cost was going to be too much and we only own the stadium, not the parking lot. Will build new stadiums at Kennedy and Jefferson; cost for stadiums at each school is about the same that it would be to update the current Lincoln Field/Bloomington stadium.
    - Planning commission is meeting for that; figuring out parking over at Kennedy. If everyone goes well, they would play in the new stadiums next fall.
  - Operation Enrollment: first time seeing more outgoing students than incoming students.
    - Possible Reasons? More charter schools opened up; Rick said there are 3 within BPS borders. They will do more digging on this.
       Some families possibly moving out of BPS.
  - Reminder to call/report your child to the school if they will be absent.
  - The Parent and Family Advisory Council was formerly the District PTSA. It has changed and is no longer a PTA/PTSA. They are working on their own bylaws.
