CELL PHONES/ELECTRONICS:

Please remind your students that cell phones should not be out during the day. We have seven hours a day with students and want to maximize learning during the day. Cell phones in the classroom/hallways are a distraction for students. Students that don't comply will have to store their cell phone in the main office, locked in a drawer until the school day is over. This has been communicated to all students in school.

TARDJES:

We expect all students to be on time to class and ready to learn. Students with more than 8 tardies will meet with Ms. Mazzoni, Dean of Students, and an email will be sent home.

Grading and Retakes

Students' grades are weighted at 70% for summative assessments and 30% for formative assessments. *Math courses for High School Credit are weighted 80/20*

Summative assessments are intended to test comprehensive knowledge and can include major tests, projects, papers, labs, and presentations.



Formative assessments are intended to provide practice in working with concepts and may consist of smaller quizzes, homework, smaller projects, etc.

Retakes will be allowed on some summative assessments provided students participate in a re-learning activity with the teacher. They must meet with their teacher to determine what re-learning they will have to do.


